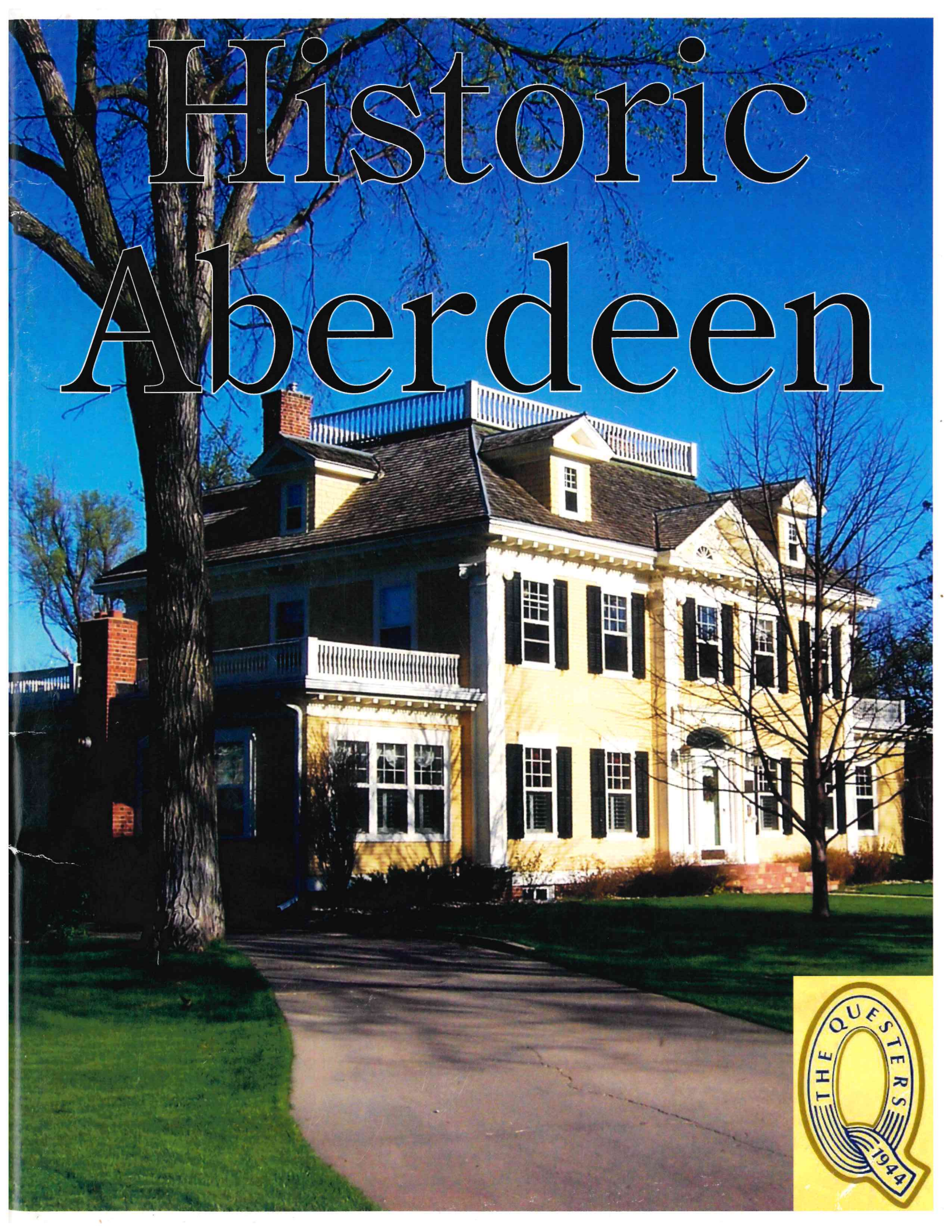

To Everyone you meet.*

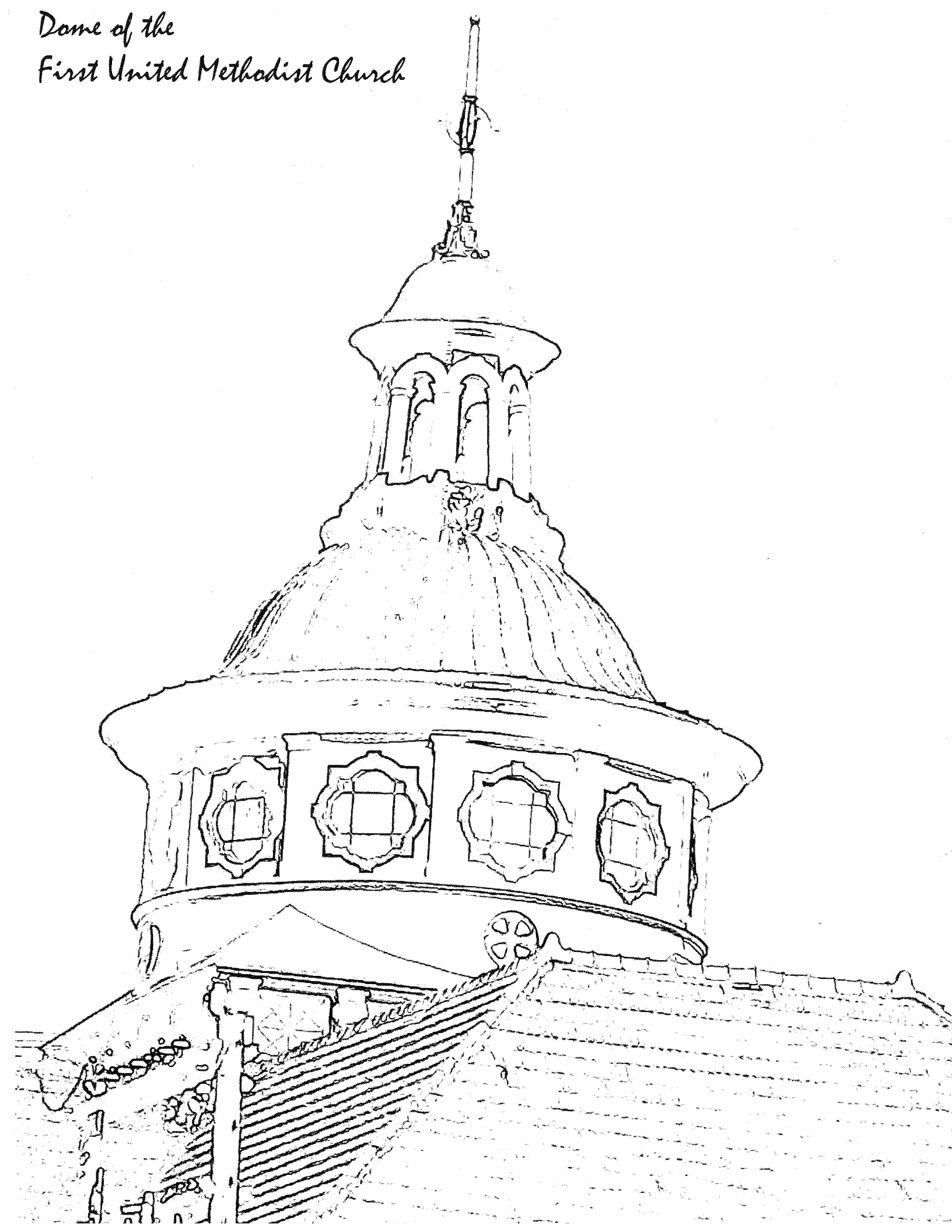
*I like to stand for a moment outside the grocery store

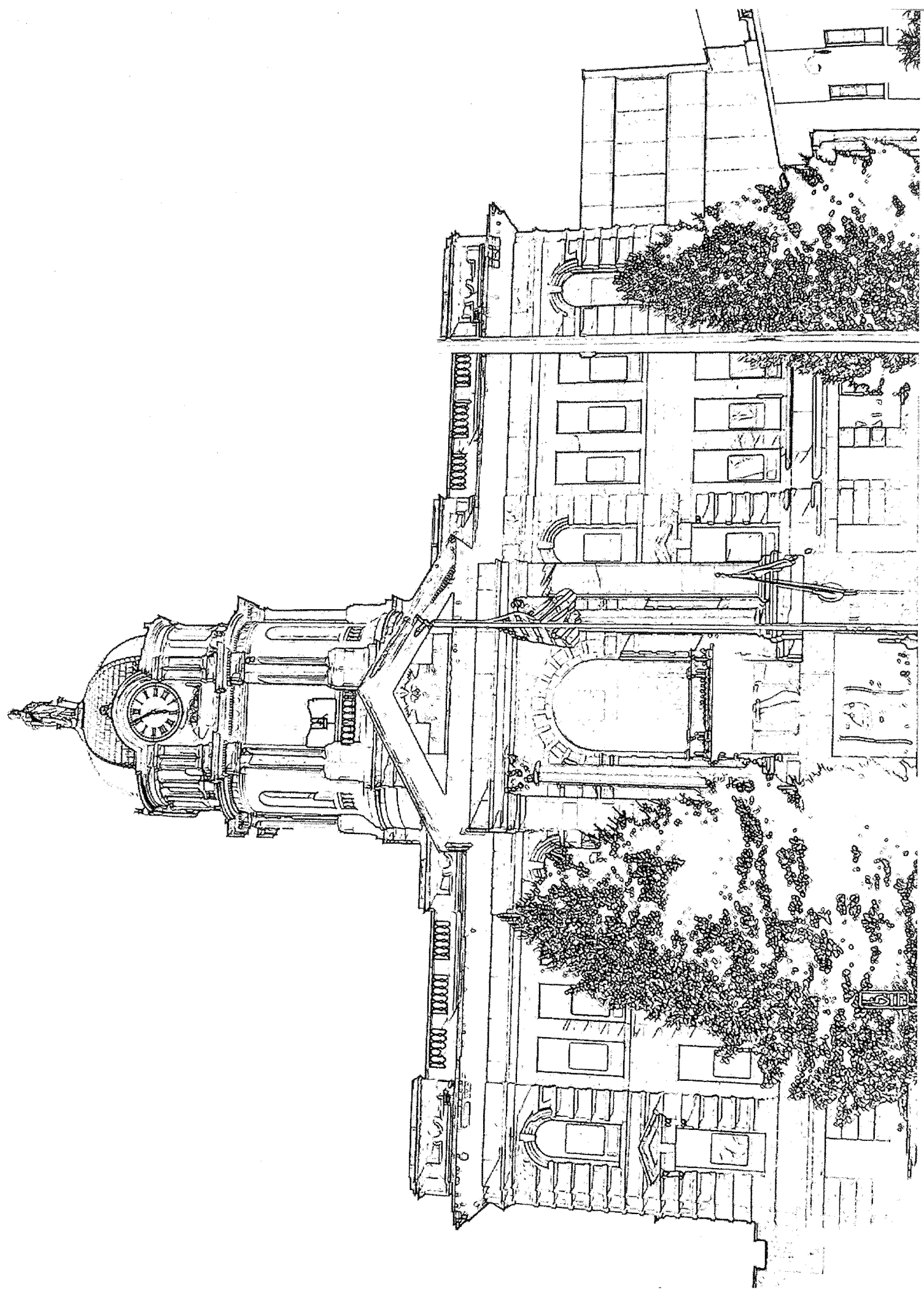

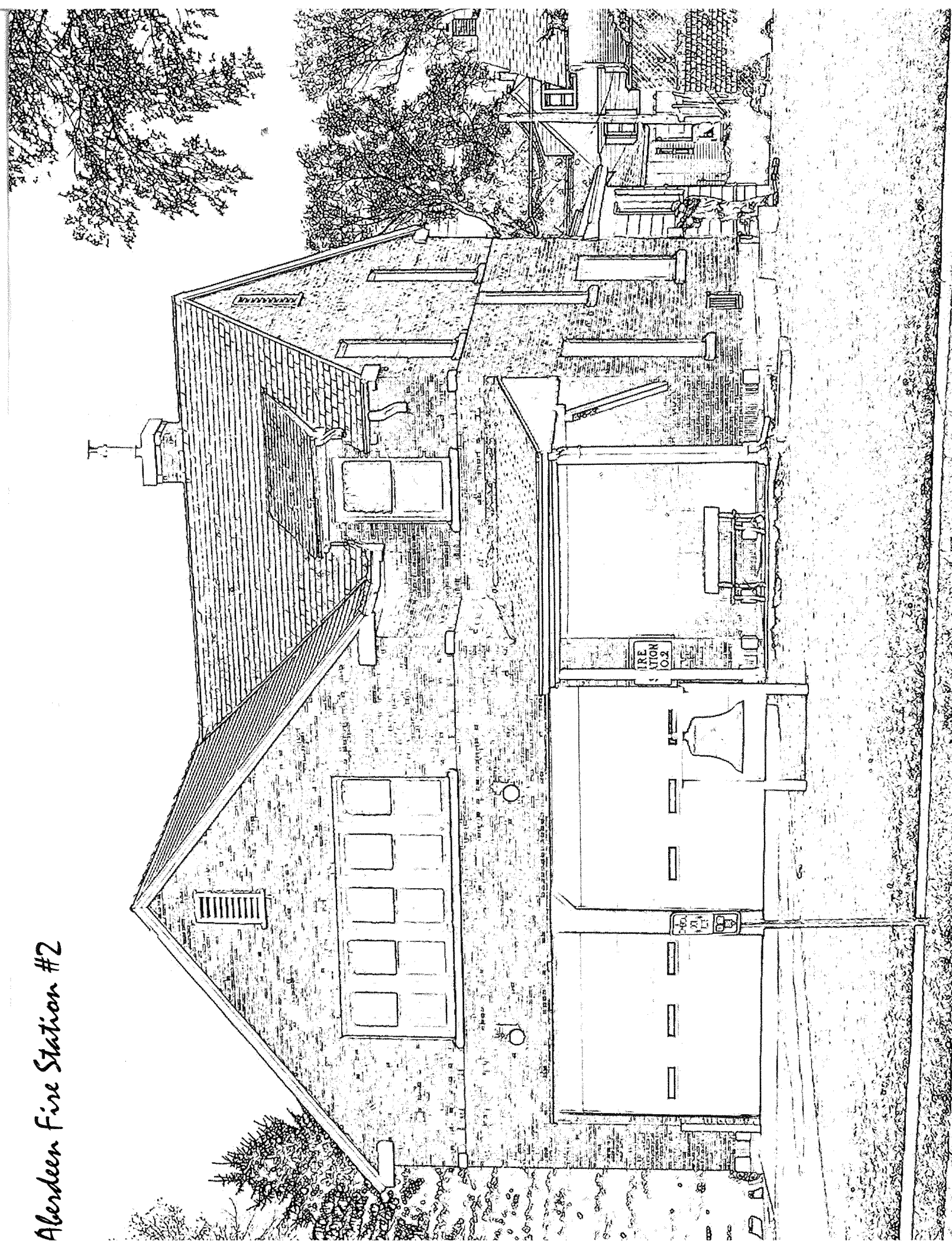

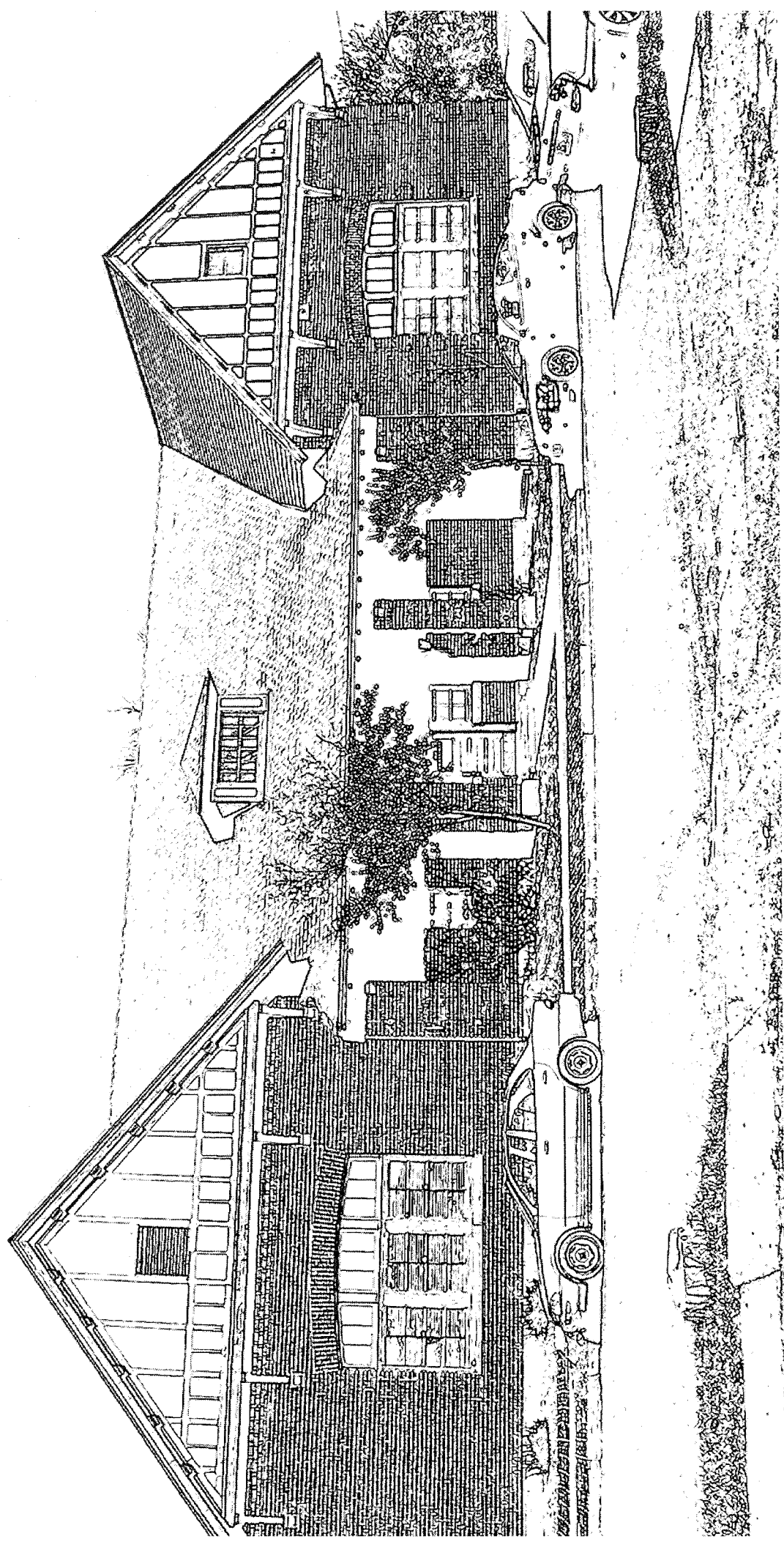

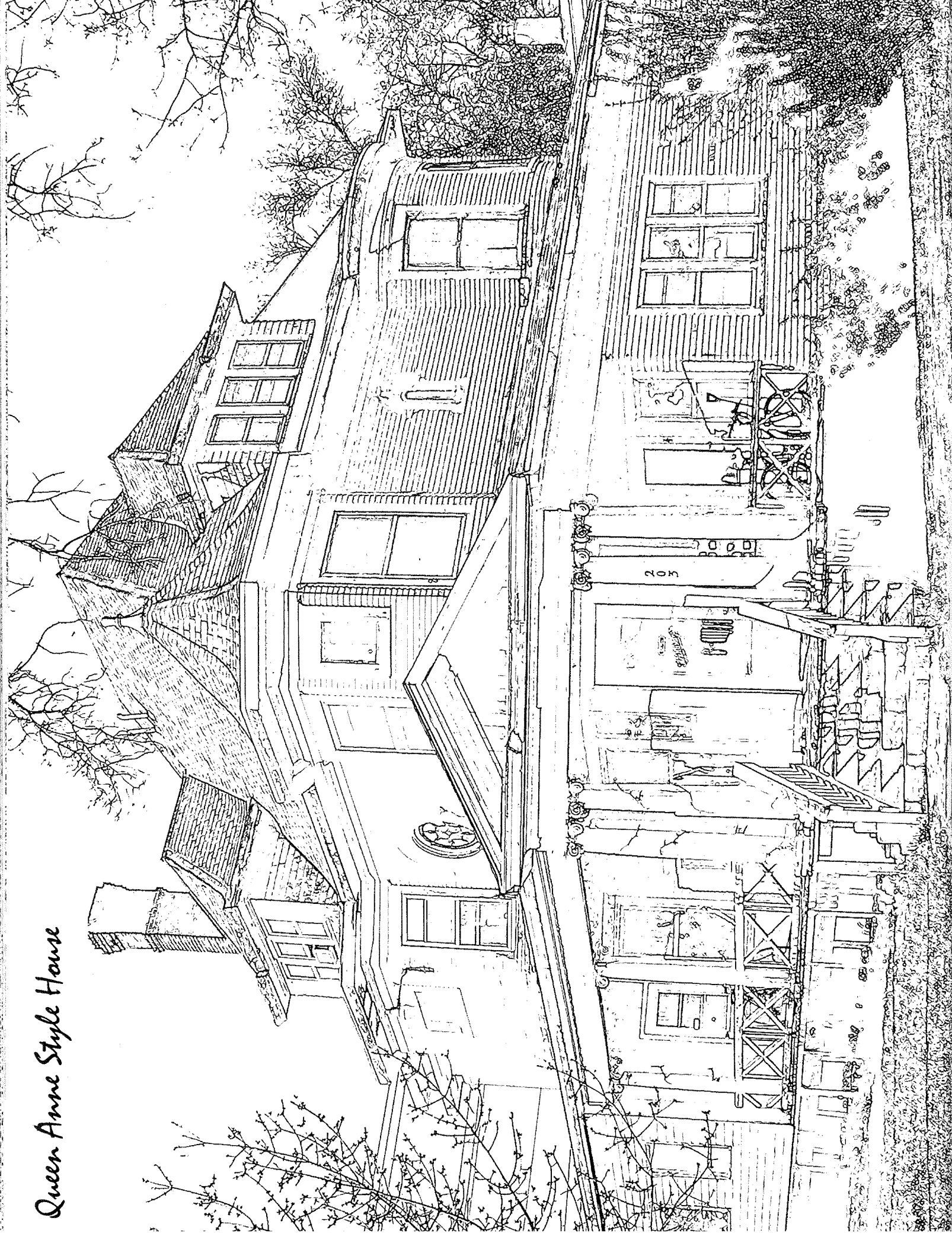

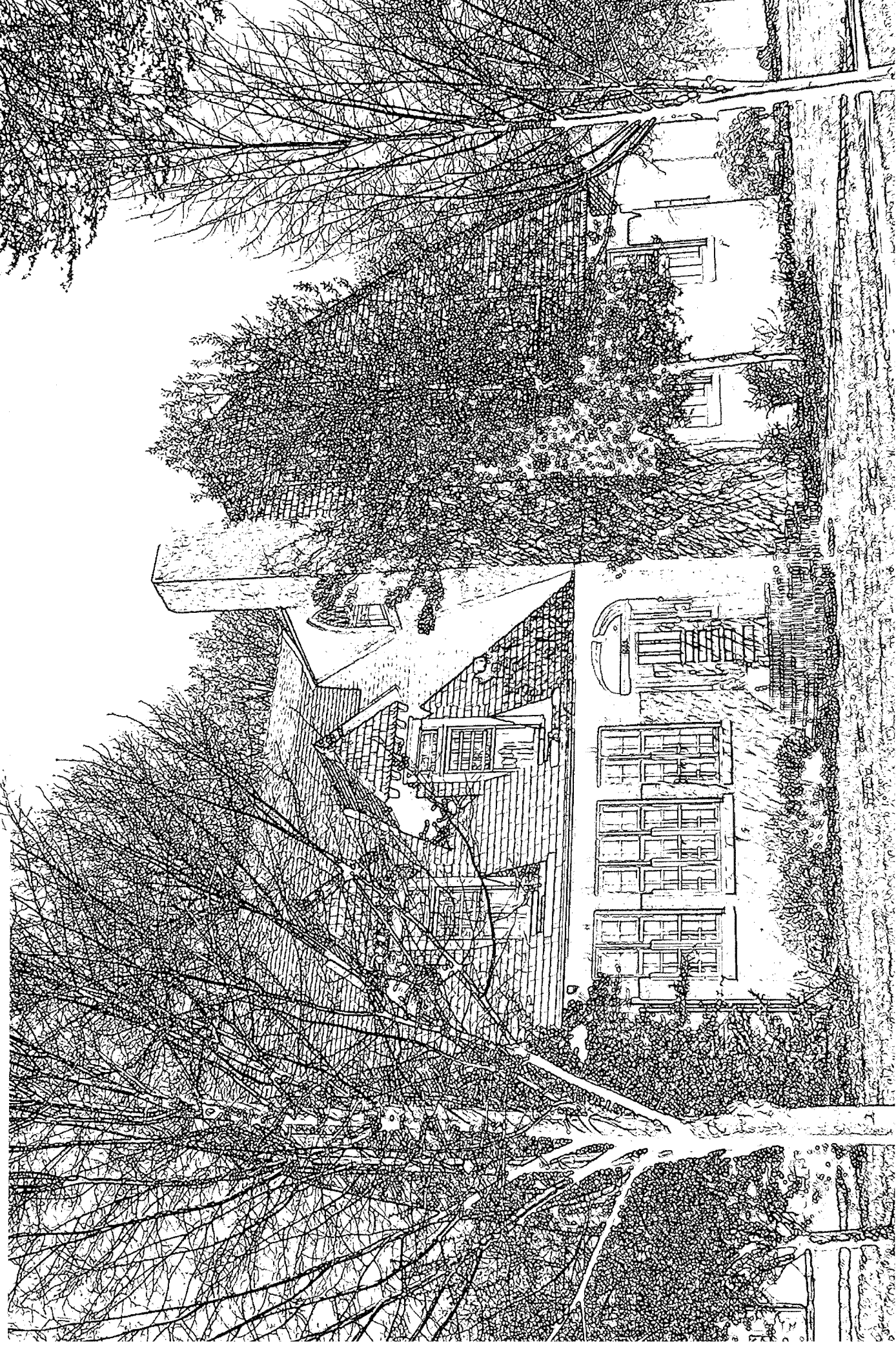
